



Yarn

Fingering weight held double or worsted weight, 4 colors 50 g each (~200 yd fingering, 100 yd worsted each, this is an overestimate)

Recommendations:

Color A Huckleberry OR Nearly Midnight

Color B: Ochre Seastar

Color C: Petrified Wood

Color D: Oyster Shell

Gauge:

4.5 stitches per 1" in stockinette

Needles

24 " size 7 circular needle

Notions

2 Stitch Markers

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Old Fence Cowl By Emily Myers

Setup: CO 128 stitches join in the round careful not to twist stitches. Place beginning of round marker, and place a mid round marker after stitch 64.

Knit 10 rows K2P2 in Color A

Knit 1 row with Color A

Decrease Row: *Knit14, K2tog* repeat to end of row (120 stitches) with the second stitch marker just before stitch 61

K 3 rounds

Work Old Fence Charts on Page 2 for side one (columns 1-60) and page 3 for side 2 (columns 61-120). This will give you a mirror image effect around the cowl.

There will be some floats in there with all four colorways, hang in there, shorter floats are better in these five rows or so.

Knit 9 rows K2P2 Color D

Bind off, and weave in the ends

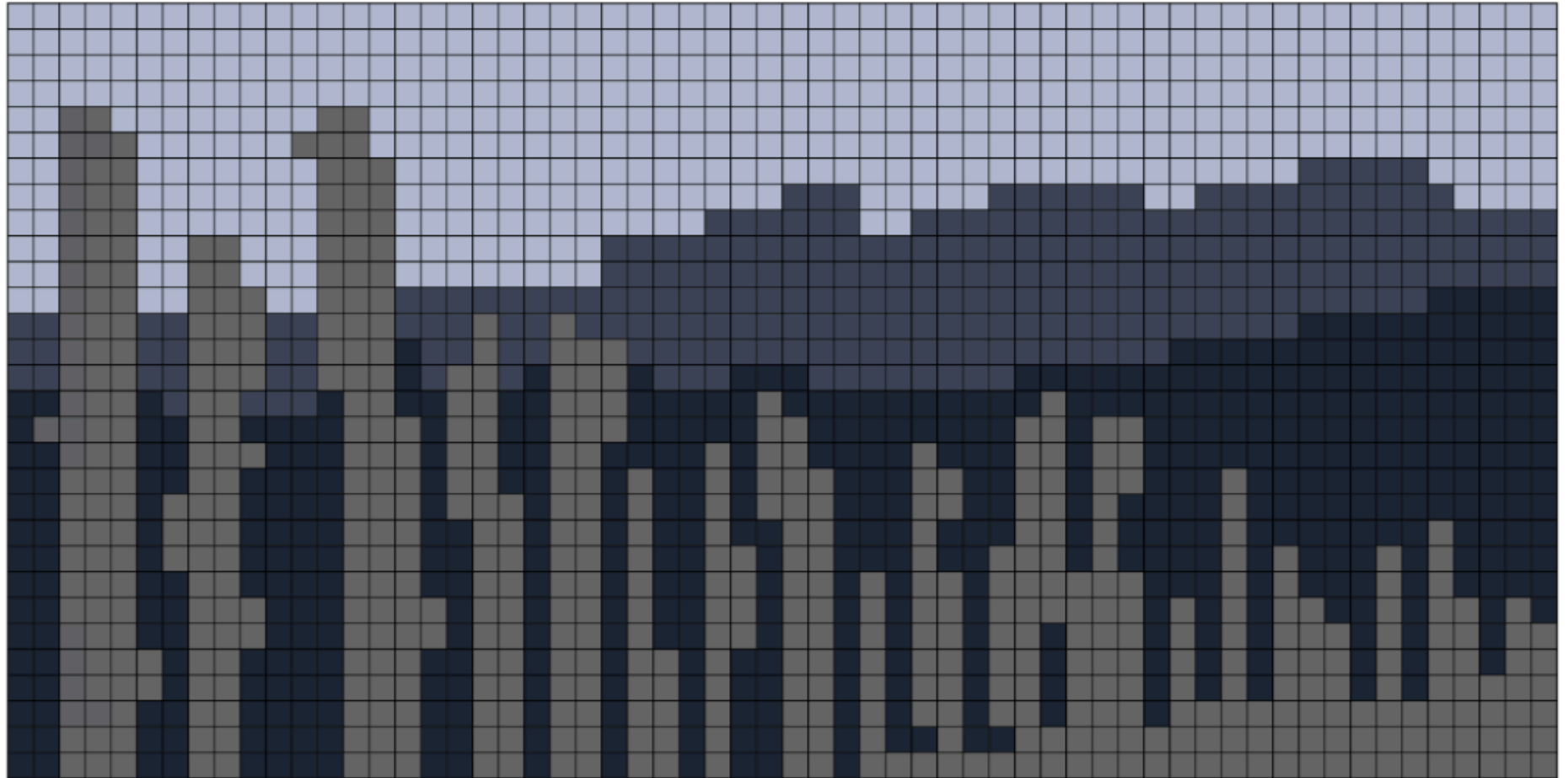

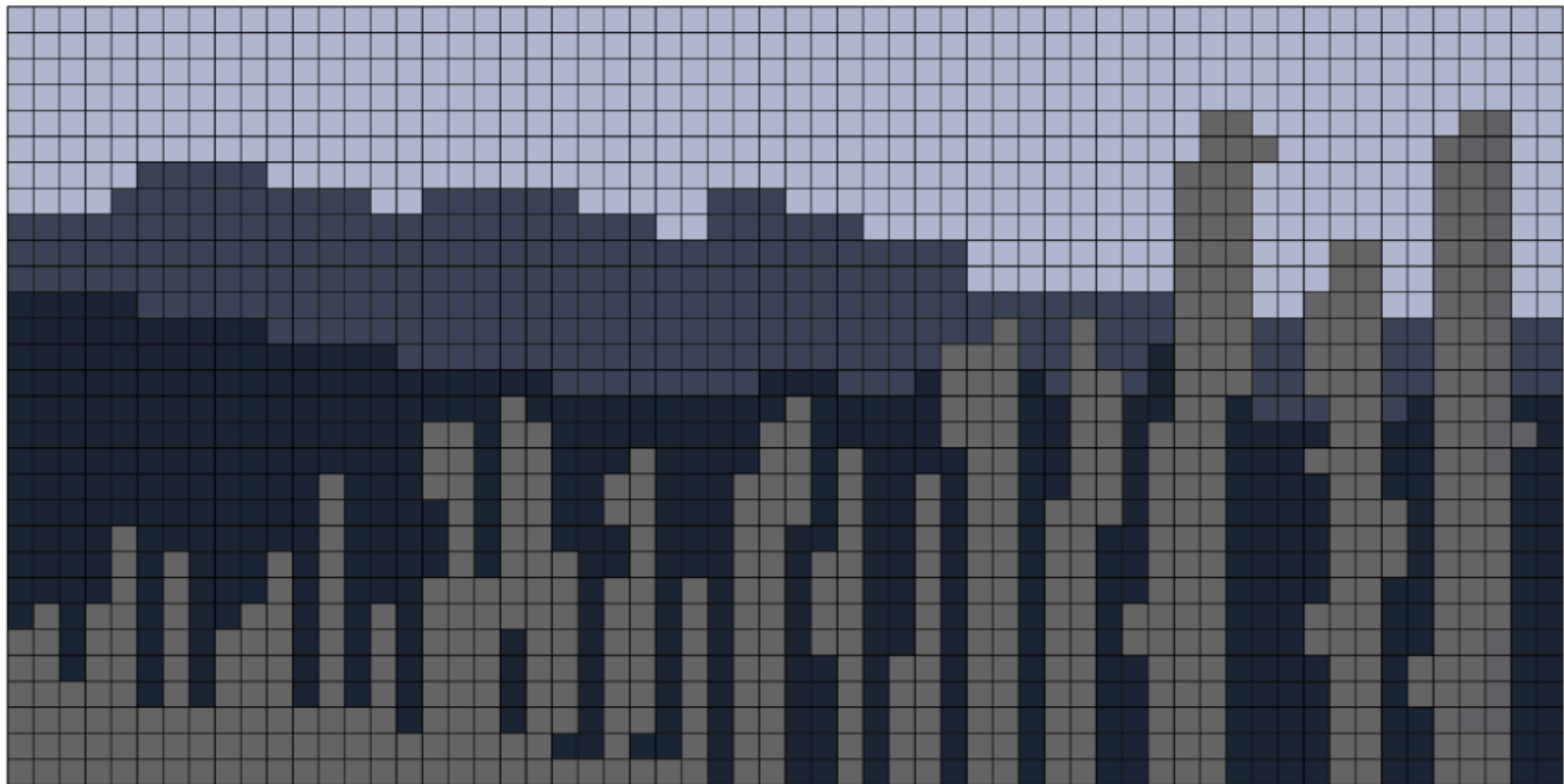
