



Size

Generous Adult (we have a family of big heads!)

Yarn

Fingering weight held double or worsted weight, 4 colors
40-50 g each.

Sample shown in: 4 Wedgewood Fibers Colorways: Embers
(Color D), Oyster Shell (Color C), Nero (Color B), and Moon
Snail (Color A)

Gauge:

4.5 stitches per 1" in stockinette

Needles

Size US 7 and 8 16" circular or double points if preferred

Notions

2 Stitch Markers

Legend

CO-Cast On

K-Knit

K2tog-Knit Two Together

The Brothers Hat

Setup: Using size 7 circular needle, with fingering yarn held double (worsted held single), CO 108 stitches join in the round careful not to twist stitches. Place beginning of round marker, and I find it helpful to place a mid round marker after stitch 54.

Brim: Color A

Rows 1-10: K2P2

Body: Switch to size 8 circular needle

K 3 rounds

Work Brothers Chart on page 2

Crown Decrease (Color D):

For a slouchier hat, add 3-5 stitches here

Row 1: *(K7, K2tog)repeat *across row

Row 2: K

Row 3: *(K6, K2tog) repeat * across row

Row 4:K

Row 5: *(K5, K2tog) repeat* across row

Row 6: K

Row 7: *(K4, K2tog)repeat * across row

Row 8: K

Row 9: *(K3, K2tog)*repeat * across row

Row 10: K

Row 11: (K2, K2tog)*repeat across row

Row 12: (K1, K2tog)*repeat across row

Row 13: K2tog

Break Yarn, slip through remaining stitches, pull to close and weave in ends!

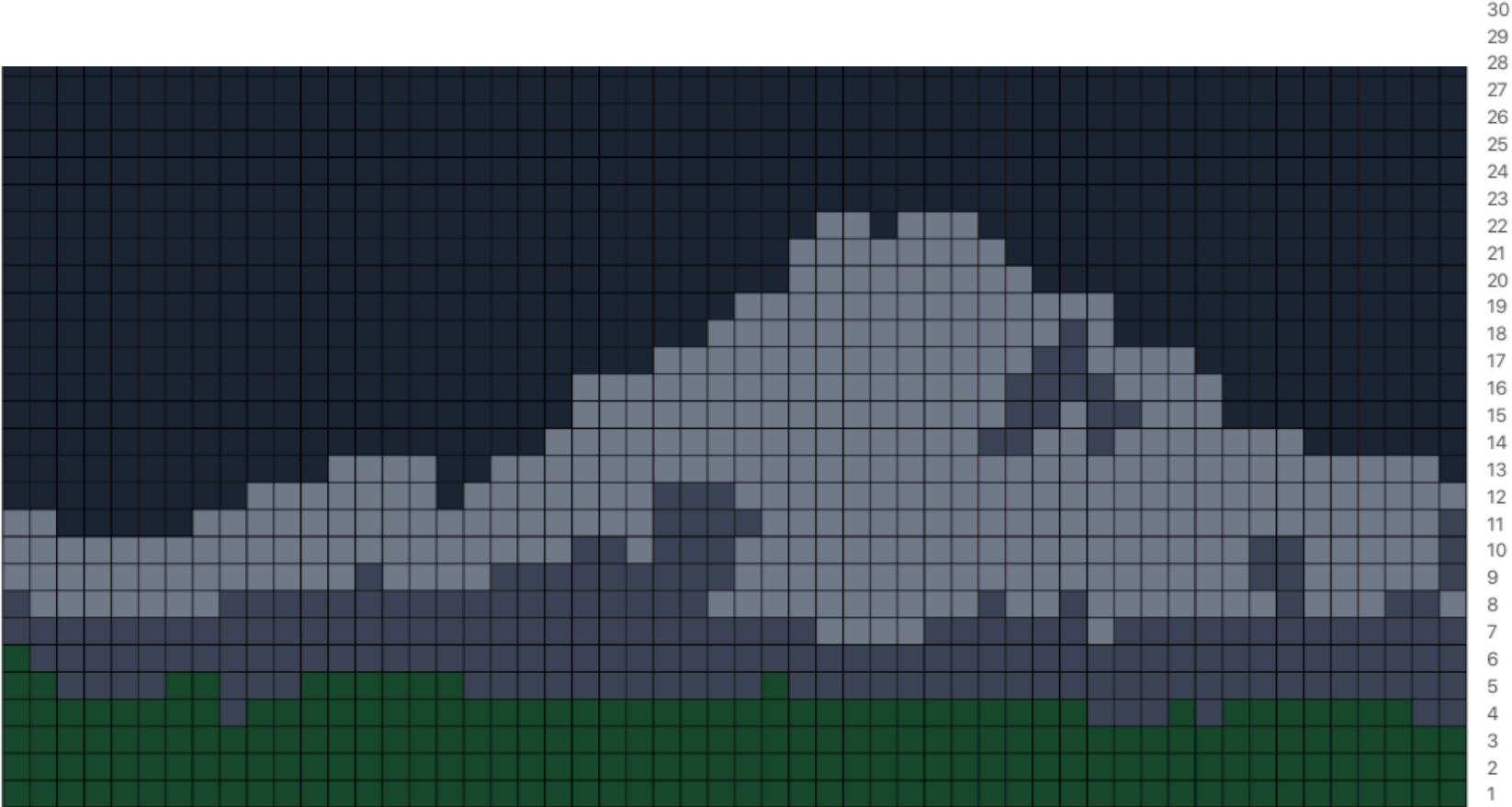
